## Sandra's Crackers

1 cup Canola or veggie oil

Stir in:

1 packet dry seasoned Ranch Dressing

1 packet of dry Italian Dressing seasoning

3 teaspoons Pizza pepper (use to taste) 3 makes it hot

Using a gallon jar (sun tea jar or pickle jar) put three (3) tubes of saltine crackers in it. Pour the oil mixture over the crackers. Put the lid on and roll the jar tossing the crackers. Do this about every thirty (30) minutes or every time you think about it for 4 hours.

Serve with soup or salad or eat like chips. Crackers will not soften, they are crisp. Leave them in the jar until they are all gone.
