# Minutes of Guild Meeting, January 11, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by president, Judith Stone.

**Committee Reports:** A total of 12 baby quilts were turned in. Kits to be completed were passed out to members.

Volunteer hours reported for January are 151.75

In Attendance: 33 members, 2 new members – Margie Kallmayer and Marilyn Walters – and 2 visitors - Susan Soules and Marcella Aitkin.

Mr. Brian Wakefield (Nancy's husband) donated a rustic quilt rack which was won by Maralena Almford. Donation items were provided by Sandra McCartney and Country Stitches Quilt Store in Burleson.

**Treasurers Report:** Given by Brenda Williams. Motion to approve was made by Miriam McCurdy, seconded by Deena Lee. Motion passed.

**Minutes of Last Meeting:** Approved as corrected by Judi Burton, seconded by Marjorie Stowe. Motion Passed.

**Refreshments:** Refreshments were provided by Judi Burton and Brian Wakefield for his wife, Nancy.

**Sunshine and Shadows:** Judith Stone reported that Nancy Wakefield will be having hospice come out to her home twice a week. States she needs the company of her friends at this time and that anyone having time to please give her a call, send an e-mail or schedule time to visit. Marjorie Stowe reports she has a new grandchild. Cyndy Finnell reported that she has a new nephew. Evelyn reported that she ran into Wesley's mother who reports he is doing fine at college and currently maintains a 4.0 average.

## **Programs, Education and Workshops:**

Since there was no set Program for December, we all participated in a Cover Dish supper and the presentation of our donations of needed food, diapers and baby items to our local Rainbow Room and the Family Crisis Center. Donations of baby items and quilts were given to Vance Wakeland of the Rainbow Room – a charity we have been helping since 1999. Donations of linens, food and quilts were given to Amy Karr of the Family Crisis Center.

**Old Business:** Barbara Slimp reported that she and Evelyn Peacock are still working on kits that are available for anyone who wanted to put a quilt together for our Quilt Auction for May 2010. She also provided Fat Quarters for several "Turning Twenty" quilts.

**New Business:** A copy of the proposed Budget for 2009-2010 was provided. A motion to approve the budget as amended was made by Joy Joslin, seconded by Etta Miller. Motion to accept passed.

The presentation of a quilt top was made to Evelyn Peacock as out-going President for last year by Vonda Boston, past President. Vonda presented a Civil War nine-patch quilt top which consisted of nine-patch blocks made by members of the guild and put together by Vonda.

Show-n-Tell: Providing show-n-tell items were Doris Golleher – quilt, Judi Burton –table runner and pillow, Etta Miller – wall hanging, Darla Bradshaw – auction quilt top, Sonya Lanham – wall hanging, Wanda Bolt – wall hanging and Joy Joslin – antique crazy quilt.

At 8:30pm, Sandra McCartney made a motion to adjourn, and was seconded by Delores Mayfield. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
