By Laws Changes

Below is a summary of several By Laws Changes being proposed by the Executive Committee:

1. Article VII EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section 2. The Executive Committee will meet monthly on the Monday prior to the regular scheduled Guild meeting.

Changed to Section 2. The Executive Committee will meet monthly at a date and time that will be set by the Executive Committee and announced to the general membership.

2. Article XI OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS

Section 5. A vacancy occurring in any office shall be filled for the unexpired term by a member elected by a majority vote of the membership present at a general meeting.

Changed to Section 5. A vacancy occurring in any office can be temporarily filled by a person appointed by the president until a vote by the membership at a general meeting it taken to fill the vacated position.

3. Article X COMMITTEES

Changed to Section 1. The Standing Committees of the Guild shall be set by the Executive Committee at the September board meeting.

A separate document attached to the By Laws will be written outlining the various Standing Committees and the responsible of each. Utilizing this method will allow the board to add and delete as the times dictate committees without requiring a By Laws change. As it stands right now the Board proposes to delete Telephone, Quilt Show and Hospitality; change newsletter to Website Manager; and add Guild Auction.

A vote will be taken at the next general meeting on these proposed changes. If you have any questions please feel free to contact any Board Member.

Minutes of Guild Meeting, September 12, 2011

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by president, Cyndy Finnell.

Cyndy presented thank-you gifts to her past officers and chairpersons.

Treasurers Report: No Treasurer's report was given during the General Meeting.

Committee Reports: A total of 7 baby quilts were turned in. Kits to be completed were passed out to members by Carolyn Szucs.

Sandra McCartney presented the finished 2011-2012 Donation Quilt. She has named the Quilt "Pebbles on the Beach". On July 12th, 16 members meet at the Batiks Galore Retreat to complete the top. The Quilt was quilted by Miriam McCurdy. Carolyn Szucs has agreed to chair the Donation Quilt Committee and supervise the display of the quilt and ticket sales.

Refreshments: Pot Luck Dinner. Paper goods provided by the Guild.

Programs, Education and Workshops: "Four Patch Posies" by Oslene Smith

The program was a demonstration of making the Four Patch Posies. Oslene also provided several quilt tops that she has made using this method.

Oslene Smith is the mother of member Georgene Holt. Everyone had a great time learning this new technique.

Miriam McCurdy reported that there will be a workshop prior to the October meeting.

She has asked that if you are interested in taking this workshop to bring a "jelly roll" to the class. She will be demonstrating a quilt top using just a jelly roll (or 42 strips cut at 2 1/2 inches wide x WOF. Bring your machine and extra bobbin thread. You will be able to complete your quilt to during class. Class is from 1-4 in the afternoon.

Business: Cyndy Finnell issued her first President's challenge – Brown Bag Surprise.

Anyone wishing to participate was asked to bring a bag to the October meeting. In this bag they will put a few choice fat quarters and any embellishments they would like to see incorporated into a wall hanging or mini quilt. These bags will be exchanged with other participants at the October meeting and returned as completed quilts at the December meeting for reveal.
